

## Sensory Explorations. Fine Motor Development

### Objective:

- Identify different textures.

### Activity:

- The kid will have to make a Rubbery Goop with the help of parents. How to make this: Mix:
  - + 2 cups bi-carbonate soda (baking soda).
  - + 1 ½ cups water.
  - + 1 cup of cornflour (corn starch).
  - + Food coloring (optional)

**Note:** Rubbery Goop can be stretched and pulled apart into smaller pieces (not dry or crumbly) and it all rolls back up into a smooth soft ball.
